## Metro Drug

In 2013, The Manitowoc County Metro Drug Unit continued to be staffed as a **multi-jurisdictional task force** utilizing the resources committed by the **Manitowoc County Sheriff, Manitowoc Police Department** and the **Two Rivers Police Department**. The personnel committed by each jurisdiction fluctuate based on various department staffing changes. Looking forward in 2014, the task force has the potential to have another successful year as the investigators become more experienced and the resources committed by each agency should be maintained throughout 2014. The additional resources provided by the Manitowoc County Sheriff and Manitowoc Police in 2013 made a significant impact on the outcome of several complex drug investigations.

The Manitowoc County Metro Drug Unit had one of the most successful years based on narcotic seizure amounts in numerous drug trafficking investigations. Records indicate that **seizures for heroin, cocaine and marijuana plants were the largest on record** and include, at least, the disruption and potentially the dismantling of numerous drug trafficking organizations in Manitowoc County. Cooperation with local, state and federal investigators produced cases that included drug trafficking organizations traveling from outside sources and supplying large quantities of narcotics to local individuals.

In 2013, the task force experienced a sudden increase in **methamphetamine lab production** in Manitowoc and Two Rivers. The labs were located in residential neighborhoods and indications were that they were active and produced methamphetamine for personal use and distribution. The task force continues to gather information from local sources that indicate **methamphetamine use and sales is increasing** and investigators anticipate an increase in this drug threat locally.

The Manitowoc County Metro Drug Unit was able to identify and arrest several individuals involved in heroin distribution. The subjects from source cities like Milwaukee and Chicago would supply large quantities of heroin to local users due to the profit margin continuing to motivate out of town suppliers to set up a "safe / stash" house locally. Investigators would monitor high volume traffic at these locations and then establish intelligence and information which led to arrests and search warrants. Investigators have been **successful in developing conspiracy cases** against these suppliers by substantiating historical distribution amounts which results in higher penalties in the court system.

Nearly 500 intelligence information entries were made in 2013 by investigators within the task force related to information gathered or provided by various sources involving drug activity in Manitowoc County. Investigators continue to develop reliable sources of information at the "street level" to maintain the highest level of familiarity with current trends and threats to the community. **Prescription medication diversion and heroin abuse continue to be the highest priority in the task force.** Prescription monitoring program and access to prescription medication disposal are areas that could potentially have a positive effect on this health threat. Education and awareness are key areas of emphasis within the task force, through partnering with local advocacy groups and community leaders.
