FINDINGS AND ORDER

Based on the foregoing petition and the record in this case, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Court-appointed counsel has performed the services and incurred the expenses described on the attached statement; the fees charged and expenses incurred are both reasonable and necessary; and the petition for payment of fees is granted in the amount of \$ _____.
2. The Clerk of Circuit Court is ordered to present a copy of this order to the Manitowoc County Comptroller and Manitowoc County is ordered to pay the court-appointed counsel the amount stated within 15 days from the date of this order.
3. All balances become due and payable in full within 30 days of this Order, and any previous court ordered payment is hereby terminated. If payment in full is not made within 30 days, a civil judgment will be entered against you and the unpaid balance will be subject to statutory interest. If you are unable to pay the balance in full within 30 days, contact the Clerk of Court office to enter into a payment plan and pay the balance in affordable monthly installments. Failure to pay may subject you to one or more of the following enforcement actions:
 - Referral of the debt to a collection agency
 - Taking a civil judgment against defendant
 - Certifying the debt with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue for tax intercept
 - Commitment of defendant to the Manitowoc County Jail for contempt of court
4. Payments may be made by check or money order payable to "Manitowoc County Clerk of Circuit Court" and mailed to the Clerk of Circuit Court, Manitowoc County Courthouse, P.O. Box 2000, Manitowoc, WI 54221-2000. Each payment must include the case number and the words "attorney fees" to ensure proper credit. Payment may also be made by credit or debit card by clicking on the "Court Fines/Fees" payment icon at www.manitowocounty.org or by placing a toll-free call to 1-866-480-8552. A convenience fee will be assessed by PayGOV for processing each credit or debit card payment.
5. This action has been concluded and counsel shall be removed from this case.
