



Vinegar Rinse - Optional -

Vinegar Rinses, along with Clear Lice Egg Remover and other products which loosen the nit(egg) from the hair shaft, may be used as needed to help with or “ease” the removal of nits (eggs) from the hair. To aid in the removal of nits, hair can be soaked in a 3% to 5% white vinegar solution followed by application of a damp towel soaked in the same solution for one half to one hour before attempting nit (egg) removal with a nit comb, fingernails, or even by cutting strands of hair.

It should be clearly understood, vinegar rinses or Clear Lice Egg Remover does **NOT** replace lice shampoos. They only loosen the glue-type bond that keeps the nit (egg) attached to the hair. Eggs must still be manually removed daily by combing them out! - with or without the use of these aids.
