To join the fun and become an exhibitor at the Manitowoc County Fair, youth must be a member of a youth organization as listed with Manitowoc County Expo.

Requirements:

- Must belong to a 4-H, FFA, scouting programs, breed groups or other recognized youth organizations under adult leadership with an education program approved by the fair board.
- Must be K5 to one year post high school or under 20 years of age.
- Must be residents of Manitowoc County or must belong to an organized group as listed previously.

How to Participate:

- To become a 4-H member, visit [Manitowoc County UW-Extension](#) and become a new member by May 1, 2017.
- To become an FFA member, contact your school's FFA advisor for membership information.

How to Exhibit at the 2017 Fair:

- Enroll and enter exhibits at [Martech - Blue Ribbon](#) after May 1.
- Enter exhibits by July 1.

About the Dynamometer

The dynamometer was built in the early 1900's at the University of Iowa at Ames, IA just to study horsepower.

The dynamometer pull is a resistance pull so when the team of horses are pulling in their collars, they are lifting the preset weights on the dynamometer.

When this happens they are also releasing an oil valve to let oil flow through in a clockwise direction.

This preset weight is the same weight and a constant weight throughout a given load. When the team stops and the weights are returned, this valve is closed.

Drug Collection: Crime Prevention Day

DRUG DISPOSAL—CRIME PREVENTION DAY. The next drug collection event will be held at the Crime Prevention Day at the Manitowoc County Expo Merchants Building on October 22 from 10am to 3pm. Residents may drop off their unwanted medications for FREE. Please see below for our updated program guidelines.

Directions:

Remove pills from original container and put them in a sealed "ziplock" style bag that is quart size or smaller before placing in the drug drop box. Empty pill containers may be placed in your home recycling or trash. Liquid,

powder, and cream medications should remain in the original bottles. Remove pills from original container and put them in a sealed "ziplock" style bag that is quart size or smaller before placing in the drug drop box. Empty pill containers may be placed in your home recycling or trash. Liquid, powder, and cream medications should remain in the original bottles.

Guidelines:

- *Accepted drugs include prescriptions, over the counter, pet medications, and controlled substances.
- *Place pills in a "ziplock" style bag that is quart size or less. Liquids, cremes, and powders can stay in the original container.
- *Pill bottles and boxes are NOT accepted. Cross out your personal information and dispose of them or recycle them at home.
- *Needles, sharps, mercury devices, chemical waste, electronic glucose monitors,

non-medical inhalers will NOT be accepted.

- *Do NOT bring medications to drug disposal events before or after the listed times.
- *Households only. Businesses should call 920-683-4333 for disposal information.
- *Practice safe storage by keeping your medications in a secured location.
- *Practice reduction by consulting with your physician about your medication needs.
- *Never share your prescriptions with another person.
