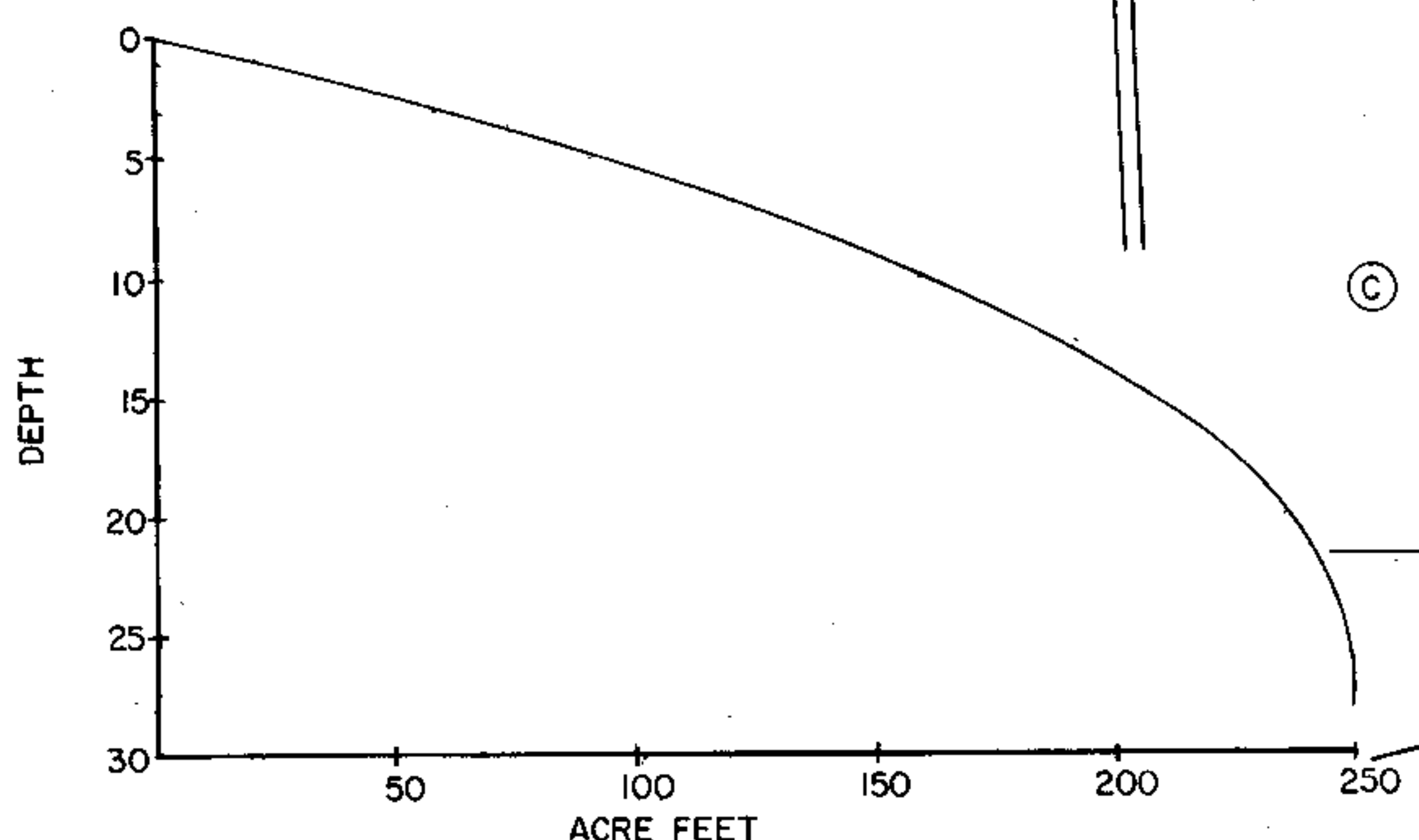
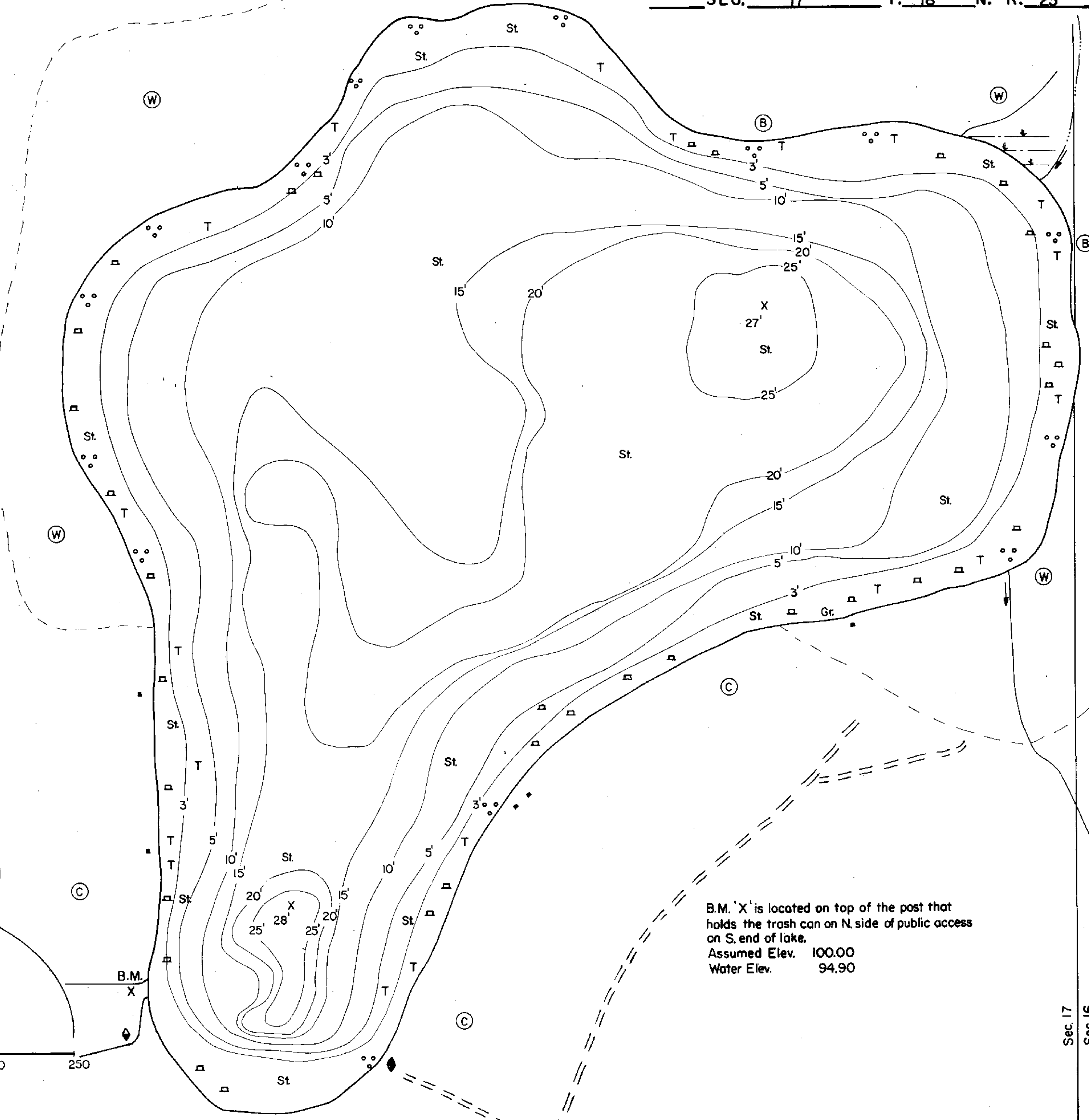


Manitowoc 5 Miles ↑
