ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING MAP
(Dale and Michael McCulley)

TO THE MANITOWOC COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1 WHEREAS, the Planning and Park Commission, after providing the required notice, held
2 a public hearing on a petition for a zoning ordinance amendment on June 24, 2019; and
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4 WHEREAS, the Planning and Park Commission, after a careful consideration of testimony
5 and an examination of the facts, recommends that the petition be approved for the reasons stated
6 in the attached report;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Manitowoc does
9 ordain as follows:
10

11 A parcel of land located in Part of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, Section 20,
12 T19N, R22E, Town of Cato, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin described as follows:
13

14 Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Section 20; thence along the northerly line of the
15 NW 1/4 North 89°45'49" East 1,296.98 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing
16 North 89°45'49" East 73.96 feet; thence 123.13 feet along the arc of a 223.98 foot radius
17 curve to the left whose long chord bears South 74°29'16" East 121.58 feet; thence along
18 the southerly line of Old Irish Road North 89°45'49" East 325.07 feet; thence South
19 47°36'24" West 321.47 feet; thence South 67°17'04" West 299.45 feet to the westerly line
20 of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4; thence North 0°24'05" West 363.25 feet to the point of
21 beginning, said parcel containing approximately 2.41 acres of land more or less and is
22 hereby rezoned from Exclusive Agriculture (EA) District to Small Estate Residential (SE)
23 District.
