Manitowoc County Public Health Order #2

Today Manitowoc County Public Health Officer, Mary Halada, acting in accordance with Wisconsin Statute § 252.03(2), issues the following orders supplementing the Department of Health Service Emergency Order #12, also known as the Safer At Home Order, in response to the Covid-19 Public Health Emergency:

- 1) **Restaurants may only remain open for “take out,” drive thru, and delivery.** Dining rooms must close and “take out” orders must be taken over the phone or online prior to the customer arriving to pick up their order. Customers cannot order in-person or congregate inside the establishment while their order are being prepared. Customers also cannot self-dispense condiments.
- 2) This order is effective at 8:01 a.m. on March 25, 2020.

This local interpretation is more restrictive than what has been enacted at the state level. We appreciate your assistance and cooperation on this issue.

The public is highly encouraged to practice social distancing, wash or sanitize their hands frequently, sanitize cart handles, and cough into their upper arm. Social distancing means only going out into public for ESSENTIAL PURPOSES and keeping a 6 foot distance between themselves and others when doing so. These actions are absolutely essential at this time to ensure we do not see a surge of COVID19 cases in the community that could overwhelm our hospitals.
