Email: vanessa.schelwat@yahoo.com**1. Junior Fair Registration Deadline – July 1**

- a. Fees – A \$3 Manure fee will be charged for each animal entered, in addition to the \$1 registration processing fee.
- b. **One (1) entry per exhibit per lot number.**
- c. All exhibitors must show with the youth organization whose leader approved the entry.
- d. Each exhibitor must care for and feed the animal or make arrangements to have the animal fed and cared for.
- e. There will be no distinction between grades and purebreds.
- f. No stallions may be exhibited except on brood mare and foal as a colt.
- g. Breed date for age of animal shall be January 1.
- h. A pony is 56" and under. Ponies are allowed to enter in pony designated lot numbers only.
- i. An exhibitor may exhibit no more than two (2) animals in this department, only one (1) animal per lot number.
- j. No horse/exhibitor combination may receive more than two premiums (1 – Danish judged, 1 – Regular judged), but may show in unlimited lot numbers for ribbon only awards. Premiums will be paid on the exhibitor's highest placing in each category.
- k. Exhibitors in Restricted lot numbers may not enter any canter lot numbers. Horseless Horse entries MAY enter Open Walk/Trot Pleasure Classes or Walk/Trot Trail Class; however, a blue ribbon in those classes would not qualify for State 4-H Horse Expo.
- l. **Animals must be identified by name on the official fair entry form at time of entry (use the "Any Other Item List" – place name in Enter Description Here field). Failure to identify will eliminate the entry.**
- m. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.

2. Entry Day – Tuesday, August 25, from 9am-7pm.

- a. All horses must submit a **clear, legible copy** of their **2020** Coggins papers and [Animal ID Check In Form](#) (click on name to obtain form) to the superintendent before unloading.
- b. Horses must be loaded and unloaded to the East of the Arena behind the barns. **NO UNLOADING OR LOADING HORSES IN FRONT OF THE BARNs.**
- c. All horses entered will be assigned a stall in the horse barn, or if the number of entries warrant so, in a tent. Stalls will be assigned by the Junior Fair Horse Superintendent(s). Tack stalls may also be assigned, if available.
- d. Final Class Order and Exhibitor Numbers will be distributed by 7pm.

3. Judging Day – Wednesday, August 26, starting at 2pm.

- a. **Classes will NOT run in the order listed below.** Superintendent(s) reserve the right to reorder or combine classes as needed to keep the show running smoothly. Final Class Order will be distributed by 7pm the night before.

4. Release Day – Thursday, August 27, starting at 6pm.

- a. Horses and ponies are eligible to stay in the barns until 10am, Friday morning.
- b. **All stalls must be stripped before leaving. Exhibitors who do not strip their stalls will forfeit all premiums.**

5. HEALTH REGULATIONS:

- a. See WI County, District, & State Fairs **2020** Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the Web site.
- b. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.
- c. Any horse showing evidence of a contagious or infectious disease may not be exhibited at the Fair. If at any time any animal shows evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, the animal shall be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the owner.

6. Safety & Miscellaneous:

- a. Any horse out of its stall must be attended at all times.
- b. Hard-soled shoes or boots with heels are required.
- c. S.E.I. Approved helmet, with safety harness securely fastened, is required when riding or driving.
- d. Junior Fair exhibitors must wear their exhibitor number while showing. **FAILURE TO WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBER WILL RESULT IN PREMIUM MONEY FORFEITURE!**
- e. State 4-H Horse Show forms are due to the UW-Extension office by **Monday, August 31.**

Any exhibitor bringing in fewer horses than originally submitted on their fair entry are asked to please contact the superintendent(s) no later than **Saturday, August 22.**

1. Entry Day – models are brought in on **Monday, August 24, by 2pm** in the Exhibition Building.
2. Judging Day – **Monday, August 24** begins at 2pm to the conclusion of the lot numbers. Times may vary.
3. Release Day – Models will be displayed until release time, **Sunday, August 30**, between 6pm and 8pm. Vehicle access begins at 6:30pm. **Exhibits released prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.**
4. **Four (4) entries/exhibits per class per exhibitor.**
5. **One (1) entry/exhibit per lot number.**
6. Classes will be judged as groups – Exhibitor's dolls are allowed.
7. All model horse owners are responsible for their own display.
8. Model horse equipment, tack, clothing made by exhibitor.
